Self-Development Ministry − 10 Months Per Year

A weekly community class for adults and young adults which focuses on history, cultural awareness, self-esteem and spiritual development for the purpose of mastering self. We believe in the lessons of history which teaches us that any people who does not accept and understand themselves through the truth of their creator, culture and history are doomed to give birth to their own educational, political, social, economic and spiritual dilemmas. Therefore, it is essential and only natural for Black people everywhere to ensure that the truth of Black History is valued and not made negotiable or debatable regardless of place and time.

♦ Health Ministry – 10 Months Per Year

This ministry assists individuals in the community through 3 components: 1) A focus on a Diet for Life vs. one of Fast Food with examples & explanations. 2. "Movement" or activity further supporting step 1 by avoiding a sedimentary lifestyle. Finally step 3, a component to learn/re-learn the art of growing food towards a more self-sustaining lifestyle.

After – School Tutoring Program – During Fall/Spring Semester

This ministry assists school age students with completion of homework assignments and reviewing lessons.

Job Development Ministry – Begins Late Fall/Early Winter 2013

This ministry assists individuals in the community in seeking employment through the development of skills necessary to obtain employment in addition to job seeking/interviewing skills. The motto is "Educate 2 Elevate."
